FRIEND OF NATURAL ARCHES AND BRIDGES:

BOB VREELAND SENT ME YOUR NAME AS SOMEONE INTERESTED IN FORMING A SOCIETY OF NATURAL ARCH AND BRIDGE LOVERS. I HAVE VOLUNTEERED TO GET SUCH AN ORGANIZATION STARTED, AND THIS LETTER WITH THE ENCLOSED QUESTIONNAIRE IS THE FIRST STEP IN THAT DIRECTION.

I AM ALSO INTERESTED IN UNDERSTANDING HOW THEY FORM; PERHAPS ONE DAY I SHALL BE ABLE TO MODEL THEIR FORMATION WITH COMPUTER GRAPHICS!

THE IDEA OF ESTABLISHING THIS SOCIETY ENTERED MY MIND SEVERAL TIMES BEFORE I FINALLY WROTE TO BOB LAST FALL WITH THE SUGGESTION.
